

This Room.

This room which is now used by ^{the} 2nd Grade

It is the sixth one in the southern wing. It

is about thirty five feet in length, twenty-five feet in width, and fifteen feet in height.

Eight black-boards are suspended to the sides of the room by means of nails & hooks. The

desks, furnishing the seats for two boys, are a little

longer than five feet; so we can comfortably write

or read on them. They are arranged in five rows,

each of which consists of four desks, furnished

with the same number of benches. On the south-

ern side, there are three windows, ^{in order} to ventilate as

well as lighten ^{up} the room.
